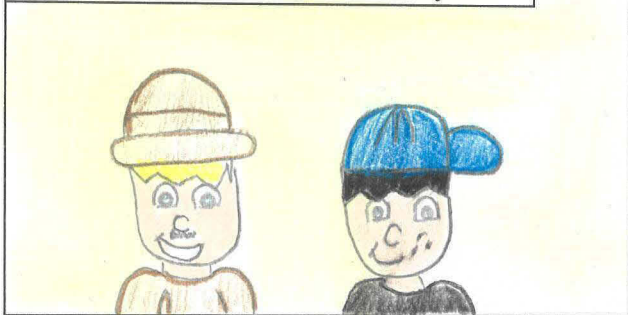

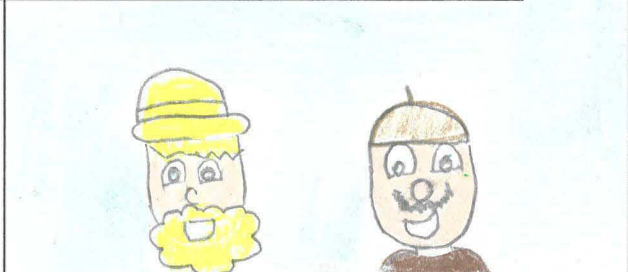
I will tell you how I did this railway...



In 1869, I present my idea to made a railway towards the pacific.



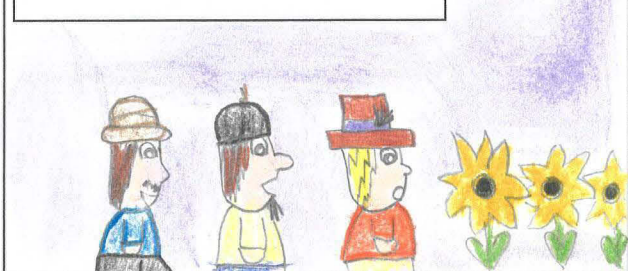
In 1872, I went in expedition whit the history teacher Goerge Grant Monroe.



At Winnipeg, a third man, the photograph Charles Horestzky went whit them.



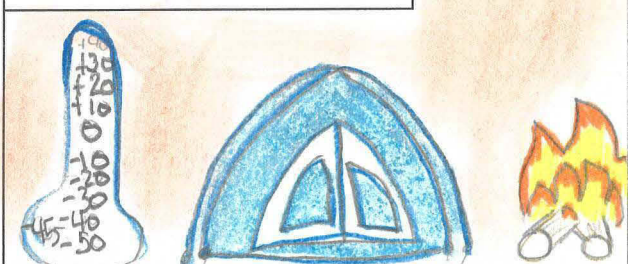
We crossed vast plain covered by sunflowers and daisies.



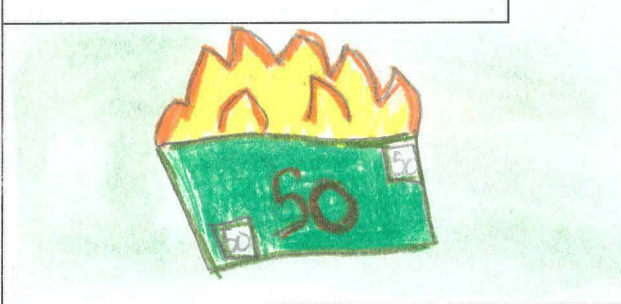
At Edmonton, I left Horetzky and Monroe.
